

5 Step Behaviour Process

1.

Explain to child which Mighty Day Rule they did not follow and the child how they think the other person would be feeling. They will then rejoin in.

2.

Repeat step 1 but child will be told that if this behavior occurs again, they will have some time in the Quite Corner.

3.

Repeat step 1 but child will now have some time in the Quite Corner. They will also be told if same behavior continues their parent/guardian will be notified, and they may be sent home.

4.

Repeat step 1 & 3 but now the parent/guardian will be informed about behavior, and that if it occurs again they will be sent home.

5.

If inappropriate behavior continues, the child will be asked to be collected and may be unable to attend future programs.

If a parent/guardian is phoned a My Behavior Plan must be completed by the parent/guardian if they wish to attend future programs.

Please remember: *If dangerous behaviour occurs, some steps may be skipped straight to calling parents and /or sent home. Every child has the right to feel safe. Please follow YMCA values of Inclusive, Accountable, Innovative, Caring and Connected so we can all have fun! This is a child-minding service, and the YMCA has the right to ask a parent/guardian to not enroll their child in the service. In certain cases, a My Behavior Plan is put in place so they can return to the program. Please remember that this is a child-minding service that is run by coaches not teachers. Due to the nature of the program, we are unable to provide 1:1 support to a child.*
